The Wac Arts Schools and Communities team is looking for an experienced workshop leader to join their pool of Performing Arts Facilitators working across schools and community settings in Camden and the surrounding areas. You will plan and deliver a weekly after-school project for a group of children in reception class, exploring storytelling and character through drama, music and movement. The children and young people taking part will develop their performance technique and collaboration skills and work towards an informal sharing of their work.

Wac Arts provides select equipment for use in these sessions. You will also receive support and guidance from the Schools and Communities team.

Essential Criteria:

- Experience planning and delivering performing arts workshops and activities for young people ages 4 - 7 in schools and community settings.
- Confidence in planning and delivering accessible and inclusive sessions in non-mainstream settings.
- Effective communicator with experience collaborating with multiple stakeholders including arts organisations, youth and education settings and assistant facilitators.
- Strong knowledge and practical experience of drama, music and movement.
- Enhanced DBS registered to the update service.

Responsibilities, including but not limited to:

- Provide high-quality performing arts workshops in schools and community settings, working with the Schools and Community Manager to plan an exciting and enriching activity.
- Create an inclusive environment, tailoring activity to meet the needs of all participants.
- Work closely with an assistant facilitator to ensure their role is utilized during all sessions.

- Report and record any issues surrounding accidents or injuries and safeguarding according to the Wac Arts Policy and procedures
